C I R C U L A R

As per routine, the downward movement of Govt. livestock towards subalpine pastures and subsequently to Sheep Breeding Farms begins in first week of September. Presently valley is facing a long spell of dry weather which resulted in drought like situation as far as open grazing of sheep and Goats is concerned. It is therefore impressed upon all the Farm Officers to frame a downward migration schedule of Govt livestock to sub-alpines and subsequent to their respective Farms after proper assessment and availability of grazing, in order to ensure adequate availability of open grazing for Govt. livestock till onset of stall feeding. No excuse of poor grazing whatsoever will be entertained by this Directorate in this behalf.
