Subject: - Provision of Veterinary Health Care to migratory Flocks at various Highland Pastures during summer grazing for the year 2017-18.

CIRCULAR

In order to provide Veterinary Health care to flocks migrating to various High Land Pastures for summer grazing during the year 2017-18, all the District Sheep Husbandry Officers are directed to establish **First Aid Camps** at various Highland Pastures after attaining a consensus amongst them in order to avoid duplicacy in establishing camps and rational utilization of staff.

There should be proper supervision of the camps & the activities of each camp should be properly monitored. In this context Veterinary Assistant Surgeon & senior paravets like ALO's, Flock Inspector should be deployed to the high land pasture. All the records pertaining to treatments, availability of Govt livestock etc. should be properly maintained at all the camps.

Deputy Director Research Disease Investigation Laboratory Nowshera shall depute frequent teams to various Highland Pastures for surveillance & collection of samples.
