Scheme	Description	Eligibility
<p>Integrated Sheep Development scheme (ISDS)</p>	<p>1.Establishment of sheep/ goat units under participatory mode:- 10 sheep/goats are provided to the beneficiary free of cost initially; and later-on from 3rd year onwards the department shall retrieve 2 ewes/does for next 5 years.</p> <p>2.Establishment of sheep/ goat units under subsidy mode:- Unit of 20 Sheep/goat is established on 50% subsidy with a ceiling of Rs. 1.00 lac per unit. If beneficiary sets up multiple units of 20 sheep/goats he will be entitled to subsidy accordingly with maximum limit of units being 10. The beneficiary can opt for loan facility by depositing 10 % marginal money, however the subsidy in this case shall be back-ended.</p> <p>3.Establishment of shearing units:- Shearing unit comprising of one shearing machine, Genset & shearing spares is provided to the beneficiary on 50 % subsidy with a ceiling of Rs. 0.75 lacs whichever is less.</p>	<p>Any individual/ group of individuals/ self help group / cooperative society/ farmers producer organization. Beneficiary must have sufficient land holding, infrastructure, fodder/grazing and manpower resources.</p>

Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojna (RKVY)	Establishment of sheep units (10 ewe units) on participatory mode (Phased retrieval pattern):- 10 sheep/goats are provided to the beneficiary free of cost initially; and later-on from 3 rd year onwards the department shall retrieve 2 ewes/does for next 5 years.	Un-employed youth, marginal/small farmers with less livestock holdings (<20) Possession of minimum wherewithal
Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub Scheme (SCA-TSS) / Infrastructure for Welfare of tribals	Establishment of 10+1 ewe sheep/goat unit on participatory mode:- 10+1 sheep/goats are provided to beneficiaries free of cost initially; and later on from 3 rd year onwards the department shall retrieve 2 ewes/goats for next 5 years.	Individuals belonging to Tribal community. Beneficiary must have sufficient land holding, infrastructure, fodder/grazing and manpower resources

National Livestock Mission (NLM)	<p>1. Establishment of Entrepreneur for breed development:- The Entrepreneurs/Eligible entities can establish sheep/goat breeding unit with multiples of 100 ewes+ 5 rams. The Central Govt. will provide upto 50% back ended subsidy upto Rs. 50 lacs for the capital cost of the project in two instalments. The Entrepreneurs / Eligible entities need to arrange the remaining amount through bank loan or from the financial institution or self-financing.</p> <p>2. Insurance of livestock under NLM: - Subsidy for Insurance coverage to livestock is given under this scheme to APL & BPL farmers at the rate of 60 % & 80% respectively.</p>	Individuals, FPOs, JLGs, SHGs & section 8 companies

<p>Holistic Agriculture Development Programme (HADP) Mutton Project</p>	<p>1. Establishment of 50 ewes unit Commercial farms (50% subsidy mode) : – Unit of 50 Sheep/goat is established on 50% subsidy with a ceiling of Rs. 2.50 lac per unit. The beneficiary can opt for loan facility by depositing 10 % marginal money, however the subsidy in this case shall be back-ended.</p> <p>2. Breed based Farms The Entrepreneurs/Eligible entities can establish sheep/goat breeding unit of 500 ewes +25 rams. The Central Govt. will provide upto 50% back ended subsidy upto Rs. 50 lacs for the capital cost of the project in two instalments. The Entrepreneurs / Eligible entities need to arrange the remaining amount through bank loan or from the financial institution or self-financing.</p>	<p>Any individual/ group of individuals/ self help group / cooperative society/ farmers producer organization.
