
CIRCULAR

Breeding is an important aspect of sheep husbandry and essence of formulation of scientific breeding plan can well be envisioned and its implementation in a proper manner yields desired result vis-a-vis production of good germplasm.

Accordingly it is impressed upon all farm officers to prepare comprehensive breeding plans, ensuring grouping/sub grouping of ewes on the basis of score cards as per set procedure i.e. **Body Weight+ grease fleece weight x 10**. All the ewes more than one year of age must be included in the breeding plan.

Likewise lineage of rams allotted to sub groups of 50's be determined to avoid inbreeding & wherever it is necessitated, rams be exchanged promptly with other farms on priority basis.

Formulated breeding plans be implemented under strict supervision of Joint Director Farms.


