- b) The application forms, duly filled in all respects along with relevant documents shall be collected by the respective Block Offices only up to 30-09-2022.



1. Adhar card copy.
2. Ration card copy.
3. Photograph of livestock shed (attested by PRI member)
4. Schedule Tribe (ST) Certificate copy

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:


1. Applicant must be within the age group of 18-60 years.
2. The applicant must possess sufficient land holding and resources for housing/grazing of livestock.
3. Mere acceptance of the application form does not entitle the applicant to a sheep unit.
4. Beneficiaries/households who have already availed benefit under any income generation scheme of Sheep Husbandry Department are not eligible.
5. More than one application shall not be entertained from same household.
6. The number of units (fresh) to be established shall be subject to availability of funds.
7. The selection shall be preferably done at the Block level in accordance with the proportion of tribal population in each block through draw of lots.
8. Applications of individuals who have been blacklisted by the department in the past shall be rejected.
9. The final allotment of units shall be subject to the final techno feasibility report of the designated committee.
10. The selection of an applicant selected under both this scheme and ISDS/RKVY shall be considered under one scheme only.
