36. 80% payment shall be made through letter of credit subject to UCP 600 and 20% after satisfactory completion of quarantine at New delhi/ post dispatch quarantine and receipt of satisfactory test reports as per health protocol prescribed by department of animal husbandry , Ministry of Agriculture and farmers welfare , GOI.	70% payment shall be made through letter of credit subject to UCP 600 and 30% after satisfactory completion of quarantine in India and receipt of satisfactory test reports as per health protocol prescribed by department of animal husbandry , Ministry of Agriculture and farmers welfare , GOI.
