- 7. No conditional tender shall be entertained .
- 8. All rates quoted are exclusive of all incidentals (if any shall be borne by the tenderer), FOR

- 10. The tender shall be submitted only online, no bid shall be accepted in hard form.
- 11. The tenderer has to be upload GST in registration certificate, PAN card and annexure "A" in the e-bid.
- 12. The successful tenderer shall have to execute an agreement with the Director Sheep Husbandry Kashmir immediately after the acceptance of the tender is communicated to him.
- 13. The successful tenderer has to deposit 5% cost of the tendered value of the stocks as security deposit within 3 days after signing of the agreement as security deposit. Non submission of security deposit shall lead to forfeiture of emd and cancellation of contract besides blacklisting/debarment of the firm.
- 14. The successful bidder has to make full advance payment of the allotted stocks and lift the stock within one month after allotment orders are issued failing which the security deposit may be forfeited if deemed fit by Chairman DLPC/Nodal officer wool board. - 25. If the bidder refuses to enter into written agreement for any or all items within the time specified when requested to do so by the department or refuse to deposit the security money. Such firm's offer will not be taken into consideration and shall be liable to be debarred/blacklisted for next 2 years from the date of reporting.
