Subject: E-Auction Notice for sale of scrap.

For and on behalf of Lt. Governor of Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir, e-auction through District Officer, Sheep Husbandry Department Baramulla, J&K, Kashmir are invited from the interested parties for sale of scrap, which is available in the Stores of District Sheep Husbandry Office Noorbagh, Baramulla as per the details available in Annexure -I.

1. The auction documents consisting of qualifying information, eligibility, criteria, specifications, bill of quantities (B.O.Q), set of terms and conditions of contract and other details can be seen/downloaded from the GEM forward auction portal.
2. Instructions for bidders regarding bidding process:
 - i. To participate in bidding process bidders are-required to register themselves with the web portal <https://forwardauction.gem.gov.in/> and obtain user ID and password, free of cost, well in advance, which is mandatory for e-Auction bidding from GEM portal. GEM helpdesk for further assistance if needed, Toll Free Numbers (In bound): Call 1800-4193436/ 1800-102-3436 (9 am – 10 pm Mon to Sat).
 - ii. The bidder has to submit their bids online in electronic format in the GeM forward auction portal. No bidding will be accepted in physical form.
 - iii. Bids will be opened online.
 - iv. Bidders must ensure to upload scanned copy of all necessary documents with the technical bid as per prequalification date that is 08-12-2023 to 14-12-2023 to proceed further for EMD submission.
3. The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission due to any reason.



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General Instructions/Terms and conditions.

1. The Interested bidders may download the auction documents from the website GeM Forward Auction portal from 07-12-2023 onwards


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2. Online bids shall be submitted on the website GeM forward auction portal <https://forwardauction.gem.gov.in/eprocure/home> from 20-12-2023 to 23-12-2023 (4.00 pm).
3. The auction uploaded on the website will be closed on 23-12-2023 at 4:00 p.m.
4. The auction should be accompanied with a CDR/bank draft/CCR/FDR of Rs 2000/= pledged to District Officer Sheep Husbandry Department Baramulla must be submitted online on GeM forward auction portal <https://forwardauction.gem.gov.in/eprocure/homewithout> which the auction will not be accepted.
5. All the interested bidders are authorized to inspect the Stocks at stores at Noorbagh, Baramulla from 10.00 a:m to 4.00 p:m on all working days before the last date for submission of auction documents.
6. The Forward auction buyer shall have to quote the rates for one lot of scrap items as per Annexure-I.
7. No conditional auction shall be entertained.
 - a. All rates quoted are exclusive of all incidentals (if any shall be borne by the bidder)
F O R stores at Sheep Husbandry Department, Baramulla, Kashmir.
8. The auction bid shall be submitted only online, no bid shall be accepted in hard form.
9. The successful bidder has to deposit 3% cost of the allotted stocks along with GeM transaction charges as per Forward auction GTC of GeM within one day after the acceptance of the auction communicated to him and the rest within a week's time failing which the earnest money deposited shall be forfeited and the contract/allotment of stocks shall be cancelled.
10. The successful bidder shall have to execute an agreement with the District Officer Sheep Husbandry Department, Baramulla, immediately after the acceptance of the tender is communicated to him.
11. The successful bidders shall not assign or sublet the whole or part of the allotted stocks to any other individual or agency.
12. The rates offered should be inclusive of GST if any,
13. The Successful bidders are responsible and shall indemnify the loss in full of any nature caused to the tender inviting authority during the process due to his negligence.
14. The total whole lot of scrap items must be lifted within one month, otherwise the EMD Deposited and the security deposited by the bidder shall be forfeited without any notice.
15. In case the successful bidder fails to lift the allotted stocks within the prescribed time limit of one month, though the cost thereof has been deposited in full, the demurrage (over and above the prescribed time limit) at the rate of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred) per day shall be charged extra by the District Officer Sheep Husbandry Department Baramulla without any notice, and the tender inviting authority shall in no way be responsible to the successful tenderer to indemnify the loss caused in any form to the stocks allotted to him beyond the prescribed time limit.
16. Bank Charges if any shall be borne by the successful bidder.
17. Labour Charges if any shall be borne by the successful tenderer.
18. The bidder has to be upload PAN card and annexure "A" in the GeM Forward Auction Portal.
19. The District Officer, Sheep Husbandry Department Baramulla reserves the right to reject any auction without assigning any reason thereof.
20. In case of any dispute, the District Officer, Sheep Husbandry Department Baramulla will be the arbitrator and his decision shall be binding on both the parties
21. All disputes, if any, arising during the currency of the transactions are subject to the Jurisdictions of J&K Courts only.
