10. The tender shall be submitted only online,no bid shall be accepted in hard form.
11. The tenderer has to be upload GST in registration certificate, PAN card and annexure "A" in the e-bid.
12. The successful tenderer shall have to execute an agreement with the Director Sheep Husbandry Kashmir immediately after the acceptance of the tender is communicated to him.
13. The successful tenderer has to deposit 5% cost of the tendered value of the stocks as security deposit within 3 days after signing of the agreement as security deposit which shall be released once the contractual obligation of buyer are over. Non submission of security deposit shall lead to forfeiture of emd and cancellation of contract besides blacklisting/debarment of the firm.
14. The successful bidder has to make full advance payment of the allotted stocks and lift the stock within one month after allotment orders are issued failing which the security deposit may be forfeited if deemed fit by Chairman DLPC/Nodal officer wool board. The issuance of allotment orders viz a viz quantity of stock may be in single or multiple phases depending on the tendered quantityof stock , actual weighment & liftment of stock, location of

stock etc that shall be decided by the department and the buyer shall agree to such allotment orders & make full advance payment of the allotted stock as & when allotment order/orders are issued. Further the tender inviting authority/department shall in no way be responsible to the successful tenderer to indemnify the loss caused in any form to the stocks allotted to him beyond the prescribed time limit, however if the department decides to extend the time for lifting of the stocks ,the demurrage(if the delay is on part of buyer) @ Rs 1 per kg/extra day shall be charged extra by the department. During extension time the department shall in no way be responsible to the successful tenderer to indemnify the loss caused in any form to the stock allotted.

15. The successful tenderer shall not assign or sublet the whole or part of the allotted stocks to any other individual or agency. Besides the successful tenderer shall not be entitled to resell an item or part of lot while the goods are still lying within the premises and any such sale will not be recognised.
16. The rates offered should be inclusive of GST ,however the same shall be shown in the separate column in the financial bid &the same shall be borne by the tenderer. Bids with zero in the GST column except for Raw and unsorted wool shall be rejected.
17. The wool will be allowed to be lifted by the buyer or his authorized representative against the presentation of buyer identity proof and suitable power of attorney or authorization letter for each lot separately.
18. Moreover,H-1 shall be determined only on the base rate offered exclusive of GST. The Successful tenderer is responsible and shall indemnify the loss in full of any nature caused to the tender inviting authority during the process due to his negligence.
19. The successful tenderer has to bear all the expenses such as Transportation, Labour , freight , Toll ,Bailing , Packing ,Bank charges , any tax as may be levied by the Govt from time to time.
19. The Director Sheep Husbandry Kashmir reserves the right to reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof.
20. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this contract, including any question regarding its existence , validity and termination ,shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Jammu and Kashmir International Arbitration centre(Arbitration proceedings)Rules.
21. That in case of any dispute Principal Secretary ASHF shall be the arbitrator and his decision shall be final and binding on the parties.
22. The seat of arbitration shall be Srinagar.
23. The language of the arbitration shall be English.
24. The laws governing arbitration shall be the laws of India.
25. If the bidder refuses to enter into written agreement for any or all items within the time specified when requested to do so by the department or refuse to deposit the security money. Such firm's offer will not be taken into consideration and shall be liable to be debarred/blacklisted for next 2 years from the date of reporting.
26. Non-compliance of terms and Conditions laid herein shall constitute the breach of contract and Noncompliance shall be dealt under rules.
