- 1.6: Tenders received after due date and time shall not be accepted.
- 1.7: Disclosure of rate/discounts special offers in the technical bid may be understood as mal practice and as such the bid shall be rejected.
- 1.8: All the original documents should be produced at the time of scrutiny, if asked for by the technical evaluation committee.
- 1.9: The DLPC reserves the right to accept or reject any tender or any part of the tender before, during or after the tender without assigning any reason thereof.
- 1.10: No conditional tender will be accepted entertained.
- 1.11: The bidder has to submit a tender fee of Rs1500/= in form of a demand draft(Hard copy) in favor of Member secretary Accounts Officer Sheep Husbandry Department Kashmir in an envelope clearly mentioning the e-NIT no.

Valid scanned Exemptions certificate forseeking exemption of tender fee issued under price preference rules for MSME's/SSI units should be Uploaded.

- 1.12: The tenders without tender fee shall be out rightly rejected.
- 1.13 No technical/financial bid shall be accepted in hard copy.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All Manufacturers/suppliers of the Cattle Feed shall beeligibleforparticipationofthe tenders.
- 2.1.1 In the tender, either the manufacturer or its authorised dealer can be considered as valid bidders. In cases where the manufacturer has submitted the bid , the bids of its authorised dealer will not be considered and Emd will be returned.
- 2.2: The minimum average annual turnover of bidder and in case of supplier of the principal manufacturer for financial year 2020-2021,2021-22,2022-23, should be Rs 22.00 lakhs. The certificate to the effect issued by practicing Chartered Accountant should be uploaded (Annexure 2) along with the copy of balance sheet of the bidder and in case of supplier of the principal manufacturer duly attested by chartered accountant for the financial year2020-21,2021-22,2022-23. The turnover should be in terms of Cattle feed exclusively.

- 2.3:- Apart from the above necessary eligible criteria other documents required from the bidder as envisaged in the other conditions of the tender documents are mandatory for being eligible in the present proposal of the tender.
- 2.4:- A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. A bidder found to have conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process , if :
- (a) they have controlling partner(s) in common or
- (b) they receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy/financial stake from any of them or
- (c) they have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid : or
- (d) they have relationship with each other , directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another bidder :or
- (e) bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a bidder in more than one bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are involved. However , this does not limit the inclusion of the components/sub-assembly/assemblies from one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid.
- 2.5:- Procurement shall be made in accordance to provision 1.10.6 of Manual for procurement of Goods (June 2022) as such only class I local supplier shall be eligible to participate in the tender. The bidder shall be required to indicate percentage of local content and details of the location (s) at which local value addition is made. The self-certification shall be provided that the item offered meets the local content requirement for class I local supplier. False declaration will be a breach of the code of integrity under rule 175 (1) (i) (h) of GFR for which bidder or its successor shall be debarred for two years along with such other actions as may be permissible under law.

3. Micro and Small Enterprises and SSI Units

- 3.1: Bidders claiming relaxation for MSE's /SSI have to submit a valid Udhyog aadhar certificate.
- 3.2-Participating Micro and Small Enterprises quoting price within price band of L1+15 % shall also be allowed to supply a portion of requirement by bringing down their price to L1 price in a situation where L1 price is from someone other than a micro small and medium enterprise. In case of more than one such Micro and Small Enterprises the supply shall be shared proportionately. This relaxation is in view of the procurement policy for MSE's. This is also with the objective of achieving minimum of 25% of annual purchases by Micro and Small Enterprises. Within 25% , a purchase preference of 4% shall be reserved for MSE owned by scheduled caste/scheduled tribe entrepreneurs and 3% is reserved for MSE's owned by women entrepreneurs(if they participate in the tender process and match L1 price).However in the event of failure of such MSE's to participate in tender process or meet tender requirement at L1 price 4% sub target for procurement earmarked for MSE's owned SC/ST entrepreneurs and 3% earmarked to women entrepreneurs will be met from other MSE's. MSE's would be treated as owned by SC/ST.
- 3.3 The condition of prior turnover and prior experience has been relaxed for start-ups only which are recognised by department of promotion of industry and internal trade and the start up claiming exemption has to upload certificate from DPIIT as clarified by Ministry of micro small scale industries vide letter no-F.18/14/2020-ppd dt-29.6.2020.
- 3.4 In case of MSE's the condition of submission of EMD has been relaxed instead they shall submit a security bid declaration in the form of annexure 1(a).For the exemptions the MSE

has to upload the udhyog aadhar registration. The benefits of Public procurement policy applicable to MSE's shall be given to all eligible MSE's irrespective of relevance of product category in light of GOI OM no-Ministry of small and medium enterprises OM no-1(3)/2018-ma part 3 Dt-25.03.2022.

- 3.5 Retail and wholesale traders registered on Udhyam portal are not eligible for benefit from public procurement policies for MSE's.
- 3.6 The authorised distributor(having udhyog aadhar registration) participating on behalf of non MSE principal manufacturer shall not be eligible for emd, tender fee relaxation and for any purchase preference as per procurement policy for MSE's.

4. EMD/Performance Security:-

- 4.1:- Bid security/earnest money for an amount of Rs110000/- One lakh ten thousand only in the form of accounts payee demand draft, fixed deposit/CDR favouring A.O Sheep Husbandry Kashmir, Lal Mandi, Srinagar J & K initially valid for a period of 6 months to be extended further as per finalization of the contract needs to be submitted. The bidder has to upload scanned copy of CDR/FDR/DD with the bid and hard copy shall be submitted by the last date of the submission of bid in an envelope clearly mentioning the e-NIT no. EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at an earliest after the award of contract to successful bidder but the department shall not be responsible for any loss or depreciation that may occur as hither-to-fore while in its possession nor be liable to pay any interest thereof. EMD shall be refunded to the successful bidder on receipt of performance security. Tenders without EMD shall be rejected. In case of MSE's the condition of submission of EMD has been relaxed instead they shall submit a security bid declaration in the form of annexure 1(a).
- 4.2:- The successful bidder shall have to deposit refundable performance security equal to 5% of the supply value of the purchase order in favor of AO Sheep Husbandry Kashmir/Purchase Officer as the case may be at the time of receipt of the supply order. In case of failure to make the said deposit, the contract shall be cancelled. The security deposit shall be liable to be forfeited by order generating authority for non/short supply of the ordered item in stipulated time frame from the receipt of order. Partial deposit or previous deposit of the security money for any supply order will not be entertained and new security deposit should be submitted for each supply order. The performance security will also be forfeited in the event of breach of contract or unsatisfactory supplies. Security money deposited will be issued to the supplier. No proportionate refund of the security money will be allowed if the supplied quantity falls below the ordered quantity.

6.Financial Bid.

6.1:-Financial Bid shall only be made online on the website <u>www.jktenders.gov.in</u>.

The financial bid shall only be valid if the tenderer qualifies the conditions of technical bid.

7. RATE:-

- 7.1:- The rates offered in the tender shall under no circumstances exceed the lowest price at which the supplier has supplied items of identical description to any other Govt. / organization or person anywhere in the open market in the UT. If incident of quoting higher rate to this department comes to the notice at any point of time during the course of rate contract period undersigned reserves the right to initiate an appropriate action against such firms including Blacklisting, Recovery of excess amount paid as well as forfeiture of performance security.
- 7.2:- Rates shall be inclusive of all charges like unloading, weighing, storing, carriage(F.O.R) for all decentralized units of department of Sheep Husbandry, Kashmir as mentioned below.

The tentative quantity of compound cattle feed(pelleted) required by the department is about 2400 quintals, which is subject to increase or decrease as per requirement of the department.

- 7.3:- GST should be mentioned separately in the whole amount in the dedicated column in the bill of quantity.
- 7.4:- L1 will be determined on the base price only without GST.
- 7.5:- The rate is/are to be quoted in INR or Paisa in net decimal coinage only.
- 7.6:- Enhancement of rate under no circumstance will be accepted whatever the reasons thereof.
- 7.7:- Abnormally low rate of any supply quoted by the bidder in the offer without sufficient reason if detected will not be accepted. The Chairman DLPC reserves the right to reject any or all tenders at any stage without assigning any reason thereof.
- 7.8:- The successful Tenderer will be entirely responsible for watch and ward of cattle feed till it is received by the concerned authority of the department.
- 7.9:- The successful Tenderer shall have to complete the supply within the stipulated period of time as set in the supply order. Failure to execute the supply would be considered the violation of the terms and conditions of NIT and liable to penalty as per tender conditions.

7.10:- The offered rates in the bill of quantities for various farms should be quoted for one unit (i.e.one quintal.)

8. PERIOD OF RATE CONTRACT:-

8.1:- The Rate contract shall remain valid for a period of 1 year from the date of issuance or till the new rate contract is issued whichever is earlier.

9. AGREEMENT:-

- 9.1:- The successful bidder will have to enter into a contractual agreement with the Directorate of Sheep Husbandry Kashmir within 05 days after award of the contract on the non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs20/= at their own cost. In the event of failure to execute the agreement in the prescribed manner within the stipulated period by the successful bidder shall forgo the right of the bidder to participate in future tenders of the directorate.
- 9.2:- The agreement should be typed only on one side of the stamp paper duly signed by authorized signatory on each page. The continued pages should be typed on the conquest paper.
- 9.3:- The parties to the contract are the firm and the department of Sheep Husbandry J & K duly represented by the Director Kashmir.
- 9.4:- There shall be no binding on the department to issue supply orders for all and any item of approved supply by DLPC irrespective of approved contract. The authority does not guarantee purchase of all the quantity since procurement depends upon the actual requirement evaluated by the field units/Govtfarms, hence the rates should be quoted accordingly.

10. PAYMENT:-

- 10.1:- The tax invoice against all supplies will be sent in triplicate to the intending officer. The payment shall be made after satisfactory completion of the supplyorder. No advance payment shall be made under any circumstances.
- 10.2:- Payment shall be made after satisfactory reciept of supplies however no interest shall be paid to the successful bidder in the event of delay in making payment due to whatsoever reasons.
 In no circumstances supply schedule should be affected or linked with the payment of outstanding bills. The payment of bills will be withheld in case of violations.
- 10.3:- All due payments shall be made after deductions of applicable TDS.
- 10.4:- It shall be obligatory upon every successful bidder to certify on each and every bill that quoted rates are reasonable and are same as are being charged to other government or any other semi government institutes.

11. PENAL ACTION:-

11.1:- If the bidder refuses to enter into written agreement for any or all supply within the time specified when requested to do so by the department or refuse to deposit the security money, such contracts offer will not be taken into consideration and bidder shall be liable to be blacklisted for next 3 years from the date of reporting.

- 11.2:- The deposited security money furnished by contractor is liable to be forfeited in full by order generating authority and order amount will be cancelled without prejudice, in the event of failure/refusal to undertake the supply as per the schedule, on the recommendations of the order generating authority. Chairman DLPC will be at liberty to terminate the contract as whole or a part.
- 11.4:- Non-compliance of terms and Conditions laid herein shall constitute the breach of contract andNon compliance shall be enforced very rigidly.
- 11.5:- In case of partial quantity of material delivered within the stipulated time 10% of basic cost of material not supplied will be deducted from the existing bill of the supplier besides forfeiture of security money in full if deemed fit by chairman DLPC.
- 11.6:- The successful tenderer shall have to provide a certificate to the department at the time of the supplies that the items supplied are free from any infection or toxin. Further the firm shall be responsible for any outbreak which may occur in case it is proved to be due to the cattle feed supplied which has been contaminated/infected by the disease. The department shall be at liberty to impose any penalty besides initiating legal proceedings on account of any losses accrued to the Govt.
- 11.7:- The quality of feed should be as per approved specifications and supply if found below the standards shall be rejected and shall have to be lifted back by the supplier at his own risk and cost.

12. MISCELLANEOUS:-

- 12.1:- The successful Tenderer shall not assign or sublet the contract in part or in full to any other agency. In all such cases the contract shall be cancelled.
- 12.2:- Any condition that is not indicated in the NIT can be incorporated in the supply order/Agreement/contract, if needed.
- 12.3:- GFR 2017, Manual for procurement of goods and services and any other latest guidelines issued by the government pertaining to purchase of stores and services, shall be followed, even if, there is no specific instruction in this tender document.
- 12.4:- All the issues that may come up during the completion of contract shall be decided by DLPC J& K and the decision of the Chairman DLPC Sheep Husbandry Department J&K and the decision shall be final and binding upon the firm.
- 12.4.1:- Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this contract, including any question regarding its existence ,validity and termination ,shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Jammu and Kashmir International Arbitration centre(Arbitration proceedings)Rules.
- 12.5:- That in case of any dispute Principal Secretary ASHF shall be the arbitrator and his decision shall be final and binding on the parties.

- 12.5.1.:- The seat of arbitration shall be Srinagar.
- 12.5.2 :- The language of the arbitration shall be English.
- 12.5.3.:- The laws governing arbitration shall be the laws of India.
- 12.6:- When a tendering firm submits there tender in response to this notification they will be deemed to have understood fully, contents, requirement, terms and conditions of tender. No extra payment will be made on the pretext that tendering firm did not have any clear ideas of a particular point. Any offer made in the response of this tender when accepted by tendering authority will constitute a contract between the parties.
- 12.7:- All notices intended to be served to the bidder will be deemed to have been duly served, if sent by the registered post to address mentioned in the tender or any other addresspermissible by law. All the instructions given in the tender notice, forms are binding upon the bidder. In the event of delay/non-availability, garbled printout, inaccessible website for downloadingtender documents, the tender signing authority shall not be held responsible. Everydocumentuploaded should be clearlyvisible otherwise it will not be considered.
- 12.8 The supplies meant for sheep husbandry department should be marked "Supply for sheep Husbandry J&K,Not for sale."
- 12.10:- The tendering authority reserves the right to test the cattle feed under subject in any govt./govt. approved /NABL accredited laboratory having such facilities and the test report will be binding for taking positive action/cancellation of whole supply order. The tendering authority reserves the right not to disclose the identity of test house. In the event of non standard and defective supply the batch will be destroyed and if the payment of such batch has already been made, the cost shall be recovered from the firm besides forfeiture of the security deposit. Such firms shall be debarred from supplying the cattle feed etc and also blacklisted. The charges for testing shall be borne by the department. Such costs shall be borne by the department and such rates quoted in bog should be reduced accordingly.
- 12.11:- Any loss/ damage/shortage observed on receipt of supplies, reported by the concerned official, shall be the responsibility of supplier, who shall be required to replenish the loss possibly within 15 days from the date of intimation sent by the intending officer. No extra cost shall be admissible for the same. Failure to replenish the above losses shall be liable for deduction from the corresponding amounts of bills which shall be final and binding.
